### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Joshua D. Brown Chapter of the Daughters of the Republic of Texas Scholarship is to assist a student residing within its geographic area with his or her higher education towards a bachelor's degree or associate degree at an accredited college or university. A child, grandchild, niece or nephew of a Joshua D. Brown Chapter member living anywhere is also eligible to apply towards a similar degree and school. Application must be postmarked by **February 15, 2021**. The scholarship amount will be \$1,000.00.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Applicant must be scheduled to graduate by May 2021.
2. Applicant must be a resident of Texas.
3. Applicant must complete application form.
4. Applicant must write and attach an essay (at least 200 words) explaining why the appreciation and preservation of Texas heritage is important.
5. Applicant must have a recommendation from school counselor.

The scholarship will be announced after **May 1, 2021**. Successful applicant will receive scholarship upon proof of acceptance at an accredited Texas university or college. The check will be made out to the Texas university or college.
